- Print the document "**Confirmation of the Liechtenstein trail booking**" and bring it with you on your journey. If you want to use one of the offers or if you're asked for your ticket on public transport, show this document.
- You can use the Adventure Pass during the entire trip - also on the day of arrival and departure (free travel by Liechtenstein's public transport on arrival/departure).

Hotels

- Weinstube (Nendeln)
 - **Sunday and holidays:** reception and restaurant closed
 - **Monday:** reception staffed until 18:30, restaurant closed
 - On these days the room keys of the guests will be deposited in the key safe at the main entrance. You will receive the required code from the hotel a few days before your arrival. (E-Mail address according to check-in form)



- Self-Check-In
 - Some of our hotels are 24h-self-check-in hotels. You can check in **with your name** (name according to check-in form) at the check-in terminal.
 - The following hotels have a self-check-in terminal:
 - Hotel b_smart (Bendern)
 - Hotel Oberland (Triesenberg)
 - Hotel Vaduzerhof (Vaduz)
 - Hotel Giessen (Vaduz)

Cancellation policy

- Until 14 days before your journey: free of charge
- 13- 7 days before your journey: 50 % of the total amount
- 6 - 0 day before your journey: 100 % of the total amount

Arrival

- By car
 - You can leave your car at the first hotel for free during your entire trip. At the end of the trip, you can take public transport with your luggage back to the first hotel to pick up your car. The ride on public transport is free of charge (with a valid adventure pass).
- By public transport
 - From your starting point (for example from Zürich airport) you can travel by train to **Sargans, Buchs (CH) or Feldkirch (A)**. From there, you can board the Liechtenstein bus for a leisurely ride to your first hotel. The journey by public transport is free of charge (with a valid adventure pass) from all 3 stations mentioned.

Public transport in Liechtenstein

- The only public transport in Liechtenstein is the bus
- The Liechtenstein bus is a self-check area. This means that you can board the bus without having to show your bus ticket to the driver. Only if there are inspectors on the bus who ask you to show your ticket, you must do so. (Your bus ticket is the Adventure Pass).
- With the Adventure Pass, you can ride the bus for free within the entire LIEmobil bus network. [Linienetz - gross - 2022 \(liemobil.li\)](https://www.linienetz-gross-2022.liemobil.li)

Luggage transport service

- Drop off your luggage at the front desk or breakfast staff before setting out on your hike. Your luggage will be safely stored and guided to your next hotel during the day. This way



you can start your hike without having to wait for the car service. When you arrive at your hotel after your hike, your luggage will be waiting for you.

- **IMPORTANT:** Label your luggage with your name to avoid confusion

Packed lunch

- When you check in, you will receive an **empty paper bag**. You can fill this up the next morning at the breakfast buffet with everything your heart desires.
- There is also a **vegetarian and vegan** selection.
- In case of **allergies / intolerances** please ask the staff

Navigation/Stage Information

- Please read the web descriptions of the individual daily stages carefully before starting the hike. They contain important information about the route [Stage planning \(tourismus.li\)](https://www.tourismus.li)
- We recommend walking the Liechtenstein-trail with **hiking boots**.
- The entire path is signposted and can be walked in both directions. Basically, if there is no change of direction, the path continues straight ahead. *
- As an orientation aid, in addition to the signaling on the trail, you can also use the **Llstory** app [The "Llstory" App \(tourismus.li\)](https://www.tourismus.li) or the **Outdoor-Active** website (also available as an app) [The Liechtenstein Trail • Hiking Route » outdooractive.com](https://www.outdooractive.com)

Maps / Llstory App

- There is no detailed map material for the Liechtenstein-trail. You can find all information about the route on the Llstory App.
- A map of Liechtenstein in general, as well as other interesting brochures are available at the Liechtenstein Center in Vaduz and in the hotels.
- The Llstory App not only shows you the hiking route, but also helps you get to know the country better. Numerous **interactive stations** can be opened along the way. You have to be in the immediate vicinity to open the station. Once it is opened, the info can be read as many times as you like. If you miss one station, it can't be opened afterwards.
- After finishing the whole trail, you can pick up a well-deserved **certificate** at the Liechtenstein Center.

Refreshment stops/sightseeing

- Bring a **water bottle**. There are numerous fountains along the way where you can fill your bottle with clean drinking water.
