

Vaduz Castle



landmark. This medieval castle from the 12th century is also the official residence of the Princely Family. A beautiful footpath leads up to Vaduz Castle, where magnificent views of Vaduz and the Rhine Valley await. → fuerstenhaus.li/en

Princely Theatre



Vaduz Castle is not open to the public. However, it is possible to take a virtual tour behind the castle walls with the "LIstory" app. Visitors can also visit the renovated Princely Theatre to enjoy a 20 minutes film taking a look inside Vaduz Castle. Citytrain Vaduz



From mid-April until mid-October the Citytrain offers sightseeing tours. Leaving from the bus station daily at 1.00 and 4.30 pm, it offers a 35-minute ride taking in the most popular sights in and around Vaduz. Liechtenstein National Museum



The Liechtenstein National Museum presents the archaeology, history, art, culture and nature of Liechtenstein through more than 3000 exhibits displayed in over 40 rooms.

Liechtenstein **Treasure Chamber**



The only museum of its kind in the alpine region showcases fascinating objects that are closely connected with Liechtenstein and unique to the Principality. Highlights in the Treasure Chamber include the Princely Crown, the world-famous Apple Blossom Egg by Fabergé and moon rocks brought back by the Apollo 11 and 17 missions. Open daily 10 am until 5 pm → schatzkammer.li

Kunstmuseum Liechtenstein with Hilti Art Foundation



The Kunstmuseum Liechtenstein is the museum of modern and contemporary art in the heart of Vaduz which regularly presents temporary exhibitions. In 2015 it was extended to incorporate the exhibition building of the Hilti Art Foundation, an important private collection of outstanding works of classical modern and contemporary art.

Princely Wine Cellar



Committed to tradition yet open to new ideas that is the spirit of our winegrowers. This also applies to the Princely Wine Cellar. Historical **Eschnerberg Trail**



The Historical Eschnerberg Trail is located in Liechtenstein's Unterland, the name given to the northern part of the country. It starts in Bendern and extends across Eschnerberg all the way to Schellenberg. Walkers can either take on the full Historical Eschnerberg Trail or one of four clearly signposted circular walks with information boards about archaeological finds, local legends and important events in the country's natural history. → outdooractive.com

Gutenberg **Castle Balzers**



Gutenberg Castle is located on the 70-metre-high castle hill in the middle of Balzers. The castle hill has been inhabited since the Neolithic Period, and the archaeological finds unearthed here can be seen in the Liechtenstein National Museum. After a leisurely walk to the site, the outer castle can be visited all year round.

Sareis viewing platform



Located on a ridge high above the Malbun valley, at 2000 metres above sea level, the Sareis viewing platform offers majestic views of Liechtenstein's mountains. The nearby restaurant marks the starting point for a number of hikes, including to the Pfälzer hut or the Swing Trail, and is a great place to sit down, admire the view and soak up the sun.

Lama trekking.



Experience a special llama and alpaca tour through forests and meadows followed by a tasty cheese fondue or a hearty dinner under the stars. It is also possible to stay overnight in a tepee on the llama and alpaca farm. → lama-alpaka.li

Walk with a golden eagle



The Galina Falconry Center offers visitors the incredible chance to admire a golden eagle in flight in its natural environment. The adventure begins with a journey up to the Sareis ridge using the chairlift. Once up at the top, visitors embark on an easy walk back down into the valley during which they can admire the golden eagle swooping majestically in the skies above. → galina.li

The Liechtenstein Trail

Measuring a total of 75 kilometres in length, the Liechtenstein Trail, both for hiking and biking, leads through all eleven of Liechtenstein's municipalities and connects the principality's most beautiful and interesting sights while at the same time explaining the history of Liechtenstein via the app "LIstory".

The Liechtenstein Trail has starting points in each municipality. Due to the length of the route, we recommend dividing it up into several stages. Don't forget to download the app "Listory", which brings the multifaceted history of the country to life and invites visitors to embark on a journey of discovery through the past, present and future of Liechtenstein.

The Liechtenstein Trail

- → Passes through all 11 municipalities in Liechtenstein
- → Total length of 75 kilometres
- → 2000 vertical metres of uphill and downhill walking
- → Min./max. altitude: 429 ma.s.l./1103 ma.s.l.
- → possible on foot or by e-bike
- → some sections are also accessible to persons with reduced mobility
- → explore the Principality of Liechtenstein using the "LIstory" app, available free of charge in the App Store or on Google Play
- → liechtensteintrail.li
